If equipped with ParkSense, installation of this grille guard will interfere with the function.

Read the assembly and installation instructions completely and verify that all of the parts listed are accounted for. Cutting of the air dam is necessary to complete installation.

To maintain and care this product keep it clean and do not use abrasive cleaners or polish waxes.

Texture Painted Finish: Mild liquid detergent may be used. **Polished Stainless & Semi Gloss Painted Finishes:** We recommend using only non-abrasive automotive wax such as pure carnauba to avoid scratches and rust.




Installation Instructions

Step-1 Beginning with the passenger side, scribe 2 vertical lines the width of the outer rib in the bumper air dam. Measure and scribe 2 horizontal lines as shown. Use a utility knife or dremel tool to cut and remove the rectangular section between the lines, (Photo 1). **NOTE:** verify the measurements before cutting.

Repeat the above procedure on the driver side.

Step-2 Locate the nuts and studs that secure the bumper bracket to the passenger side frame rail. Remove the (2) outer nuts and install (I) rectangular spacer over the upper stud .Note: The rectangular spacer is only used on models equipped with factory tow hooks, (Photo 2).






Step-3 Position the passenger side frame bracket over the studs and secure the bracket to the frame using the (2) factory nuts, (Photo 3). Leave the nuts loose for final adjustment.

Step-4 Insert the passenger side extension bracket up through the opening cut in the air dam. Attach the extension bracket to the frame bracket using (2) $I/2" \times 1 \frac{1}{2}"$ carriage bolts, (2) $\frac{1}{2}"$ flat washers, (2) $\frac{1}{2}"$ lock washers and (2) $\frac{1}{2}"$ hex nuts, (Photo 4). Leave the nuts and bolts loose for final adjustment.

Repeat the above procedure to install the driver side frame and extension bracket.








Step-5 To install the auxiliary bracket use the provided template to cut out the bumper's lower cover position the auxiliary bracket through the opening cut out in the lower cover, (Photo 5).


Step-6 Remove the lower nut, washers and carriage bolt securing the extension bracket to the frame bracket. Attach the auxiliary bracket to the tow hook support using (1) 7/16" x 5" hex bolt, (2) 7/16" flat washers, (1) 7/16" lock washer and (1) 7/16" hex nut, Align the hole in the auxiliary bracket with the holes in the frame and auxiliary bracket and reinstall the $\frac{1}{2}$ " carriage bolts washers and nut, (Photo 6). Leave the nuts and bolts loose for final adjustment.


Repeat the above procedure to install the driver side frame and extension bracket.





Step-7 Position the grille guard up to the brackets and attach the grille guard to the outside of each bracket using the black finish 1/2" x 1 1/2" hex bolts, 1/2" flat washers, 1/2" lock washers and 1/2" hex nuts supplied, (Photo 7 & 8).

Step-8 Align the grille guard with the vehicle and tighten the factory and supplied nuts and bolts.

Step-9 Remember to check and retighten all nuts and bolts hardware periodically.
