


Instructions: Aproximated installation time: 40 min.

1. Before beginning installation, please read all directions carefully and verify all necessary hardware is accounted for. If any parts are missing, stop the installation and contact your distributor.

2. If vehicle has tow hooks proceed to remove the bolt located toward the front of the vehicle and loosen the rear bolt. See Img. 1. If vehicle does not have tow hooks follow step 4.



3. Place lower bracket over the exposed tow hook bolt and reinstall the tow hook over the Euroquard bracket. Re-install using the original equipment bolts removed in step 2. Img. 2. Leave loose. Follow step 8.


- 4. If the vehicle **does not have** tow hooks, use the template, printed below, as a guide to modify the lower valance. NOTE: Before proceeding with the valance modification, make sure that the supplied paper template has the dimensions clearly printed and check them out. PROFESSIONAL INSTALLATION RECOMMENDED
- 5. Align paper path to the edges shown at image 3, mark area to cut out and proceed. Repeat for opposite side.
- 6. Once openings were made, place tab bolts into the chassis as shown at Img. 4. Use the wire guide to place tab bolts.



- 8. Remove the bolt at the top of the factory bumper support bracket.. Img. 6
- 9. Locate at chassis the 1" Ø hole faces exterior then place "T" bolt introducing the steel bar into the chassis. Img. 6 Once "T" bolt has been placed put on a vinyl gasket to prevent fall off into the chassis.












10 . **Place auxiliary upper bracket** then fasten the bend end to the bumper support using M8x40 hex head bolt with 1/4" flat washer, secure the other end to the chassis using 3/8" flat and lock washer and hex nut. Leave loose.




11 . Insert by front of bumper the upper bracket and fasten to the auxiliary upper bracket with  $3/8 \times 1$ " carrriage head bolt, 3/8" flat and lock washer and hex nut. Img. 8



- 12 . Place Front Guard as **image 9**, to secure lower bracket use  $1/2 \times 1.1/4$ " carriage head bolt, 1/2" flat washer and 1/2" lock nut. Secure to upper bracket using  $3/8 \times 1.1/4$ " carriage head bolt, 3/8" flat washer and 3/8" lock nut. Leave loose.
- 13 . Only Front modular guard version. Install the brush guards using a gasket between the side plates and the brush guards. Secure into a place using  $3/8 \times 1 1/2$ " button Allen head bolts, and corresponding nuts and washers. Leave hardware loose.
- 14. Make any final adjustments to the alignment of the Front Guard and tighten all bolts from bottom to top. **Note: Before tightening the bolts, make sure the upper bracket does not interfere with opening and closing of the hood.**
- 15. Do not use abrasive substances or polish to clean your product.
- 16. You may need to periodically re-tighten the bolts.
- 17. Fill out included warranty card and put in your vehicle.





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
